56.01 PURPOSE. The purpose of registering and tagging pets is for identification if the pet is lost, to prevent pets from being destroyed as stray.

56.02 ANNUAL REGISTRATION. The owner of a dog or cat over six (6) months of age shall register said dog or cat with the Clerk prior to the first of January of each year.

56.03 REQUIREMENTS. The owner of a dog or cat for which registration is required shall provide proof of current vaccination against rabies, a photograph sufficient to identify the dog or cat, and such other information as the Clerk requires.

56.04 REGISTRATION FEES. The initial registration fee for each dog or cat is five dollars (\$5.00). Each subsequent annual registration fee is one dollar (\$1.00).

56.05 REGISTRATION TAG. Upon registration of a dog or cat and receipt of the fee, the Clerk shall deliver or mail to the owner of said dog or cat a registration tag which will be worn by the dog or cat at all times.
